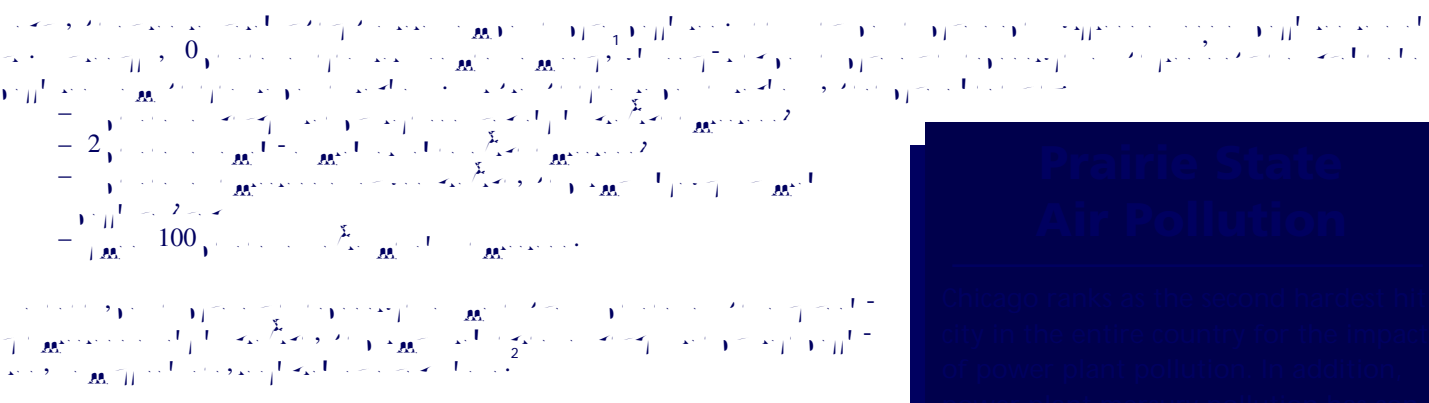


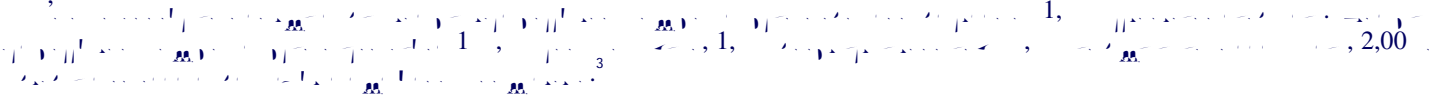
Power Plants: The Number One Polluter
