Illinois Habitat: This tree grows in rich woodlands statewide.

Flowering: Flowering occurs in April and May, when the leaves are partly grown same tree. Male flowers develop in yellow-green catkins. Female flowers are arrang Uses: The wood of this tree is used for making furniture, cabinets and in interior fiby wildlife.

General Description: This tree may grow to a height of 150 feet and a trunk diam divided by partitions.

Bark: The bark is thick and black with deep ridges.

**Leaf:** Leaves are arranged alternately on the stem. A leaf may have from 15 to 23 half inches long and one and one-half inches wide. The leaflet is toothed along the **Fruit:** The spherical fruits develop singly or in pairs. Each fruit may be up to two and the enclosed nut is hard, dark brown and deeply ridged. The seed tastes sweet.
