Illinois Habitat: This tree grows in rich woodlands statewide.
Flowering: Flowering occurs in April and May, when the leaves are partly grown on the same tree. Male flowers develop in yellow-green catkins. Female flowers are arranged in clusters.
Uses: The wood of this tree is used for making furniture, cabinets and in interior finishing by wildlife.
General Description: This tree may grow to a height of 150 feet and a trunk diameter of 4 feet, divided by partitions.
Bark: The bark is thick and black with deep ridges.
Leaf: Leaves are arranged alternately on the stem. A leaf may have from 15 to 23 leaflets half inches long and one and one-half inches wide. The leaflet is toothed along the margins.
Fruit: The spherical fruits develop singly or in pairs. Each fruit may be up to two inches in diameter and the enclosed nut is hard, dark brown and deeply ridged. The seed tastes sweet.

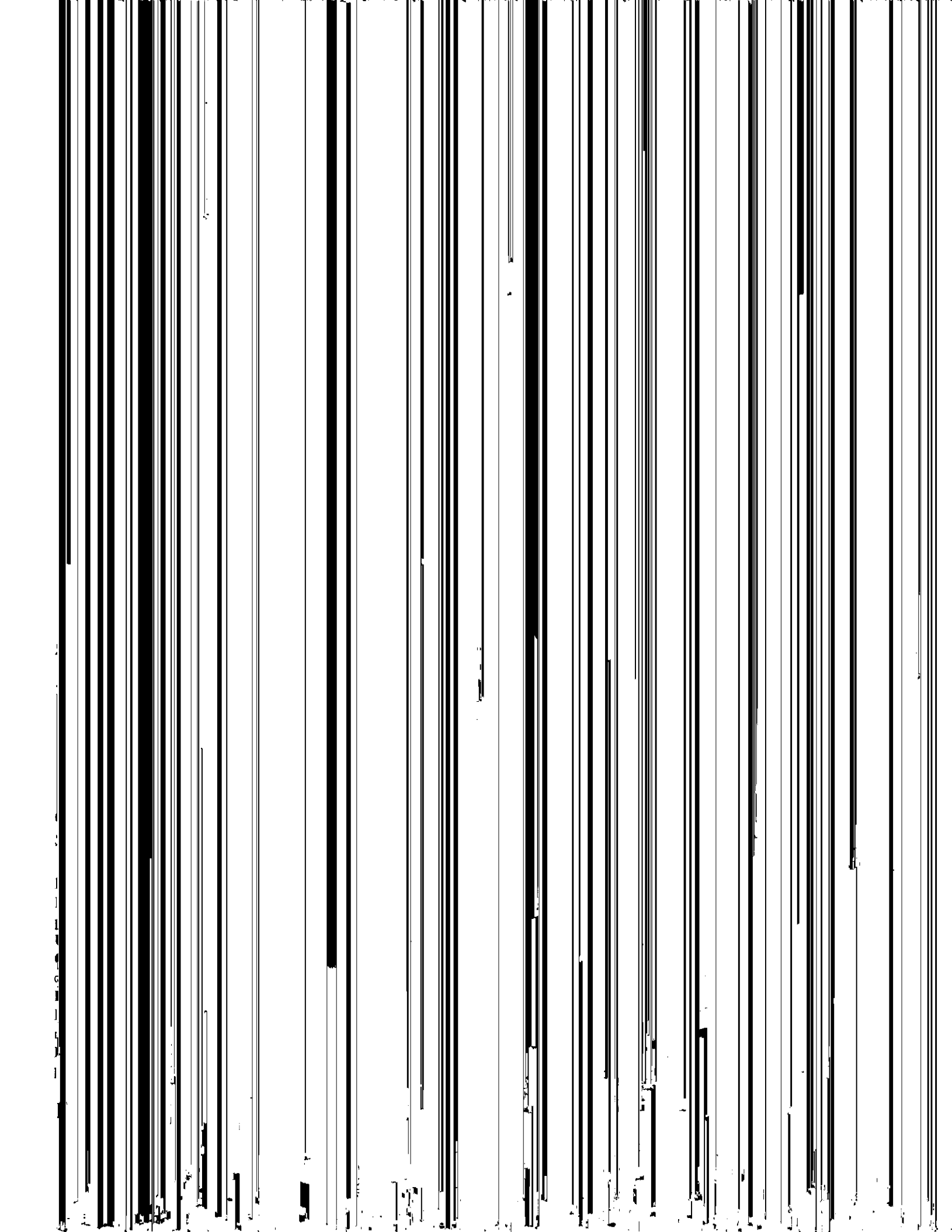

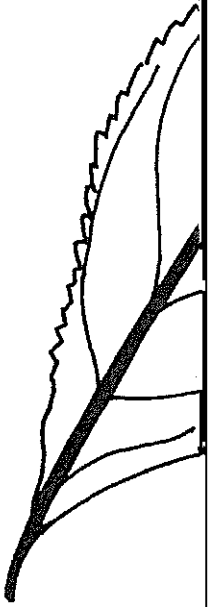

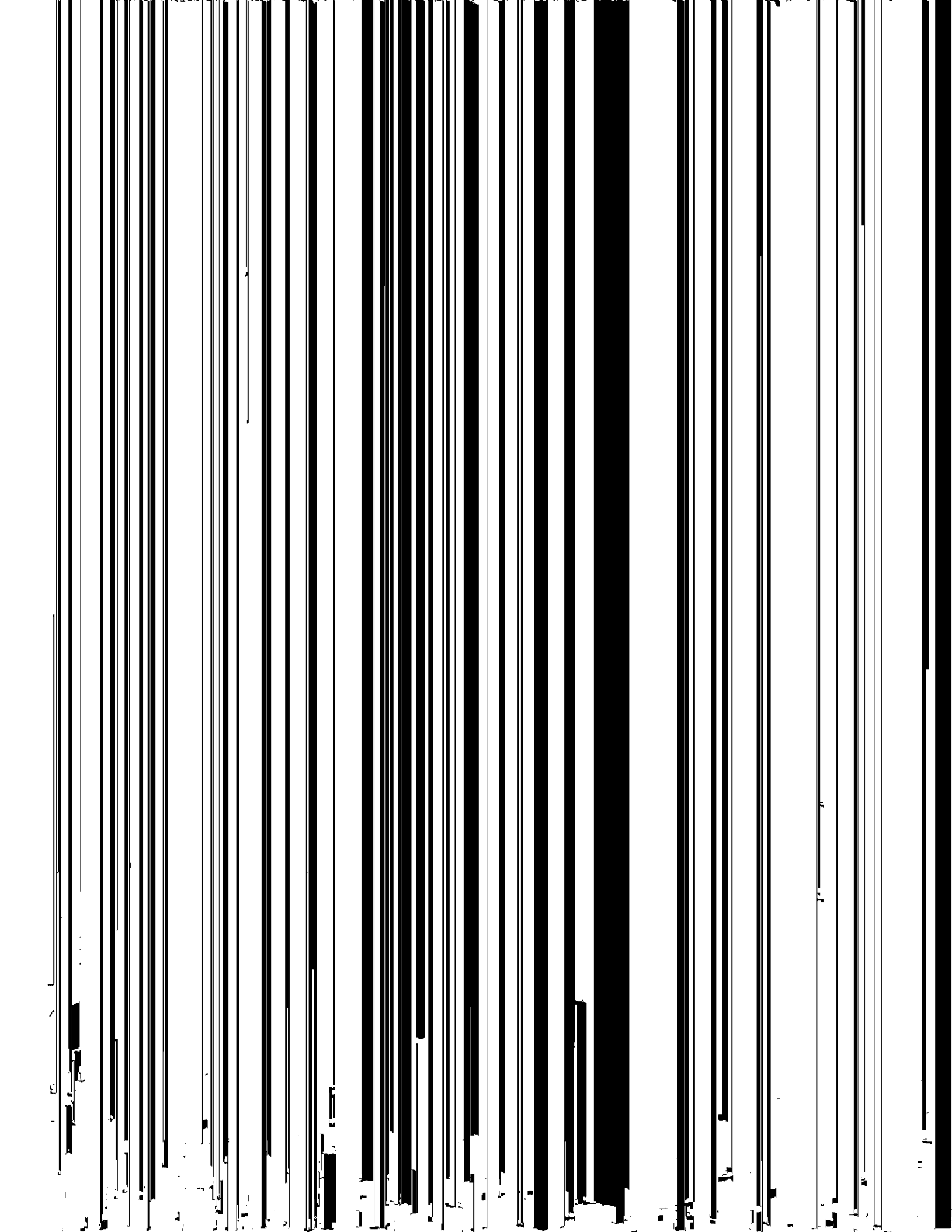
