PROGRAM ASSESSMENT

Students majoring in finance are expected to fulfill the following three assessment requirements:

Capstone Analysis - a pre and post examination will be given in 4000 level finance courses. The purpose of the examination is to assess student understanding of financial concepts, ratios, and computations.

Standardized Field Test Examination . all College of Business students must take a standardized field test examination in business. This examination is given in MGMT 4890/ 389. The purpose of the examination is to provide students with feedback on their mastery of general business concepts compared to other senior students. The examination covers general business concepts, ratios, and interpretations, and interpret material is also covered in the examination.

Senior Exit Interview - all graduating seniors are required to complete a senior exit interview questionnaire as part of their application for graduation. The purpose of the questionnaire is to gather feedback regarding his or her academic experience at CSU. The senior exit interview forms can be obtained from the department secretary.

Senior Thesis - Assessment results will be used to evaluate the quality of learning within the finance program. The results will also be the basis for any future revisions in the curriculum.
