The Psychology Department has an undergraduate and a graduate committee, which decide the number of online courses that should be available for the program, and to some extent, which courses these will be. The chairperson reviews the course offerings and makes the final decision about what should be offered. Enrollment history is a major factor. The chairperson suggests improvement by reviewing online courses as part of the instructor's teaching evaluation.

Faculty members are paired when someone is teaching online for the first time.

The Psychology Department has an advising center with a full time advisor and
